2. How is the power of God's Word shown in John 4:46 – 54?
3. What promises are yours if you continue in His Word? What do you think it means to "continue" in His Word? (John 8:31 – 32)

SALVATION THROUGH GOD'S WORD

4. What is God's Word able to do? (2 Timothy 3:15, James 1:21)
5. Write out 1 Peter 1:23 in your own words.
6. Psalm 119:9, You make your life clean by ...
7. What are you expected to do as a Christian? (2 Peter 3:18)
8. What did Paul tell the elders of the Ephesian Church that the Word of God could do for them? (Acts 20:32)
9. What can choke the Word of God in your life? (Luke 8:14)
10. What promises and warnings does Christ give you about His Word? (John 15:11, 16:33, Matthew 24:35, Revelation 22:18 – 19)
11. What attitudes towards His Word does God command? (Psalm 112:1, Psalm 119:167)

12. What kind of heart will best hear and use the Word? (Luke 8:15)
13. In proclaiming the Word, what can pastors and teachers do? (Nehemiah 8:8)
14. Whom did Jesus say would be blessed? (Luke 11:28)

15. List reasons for daily reading your Bible. (Deuteronomy 17:19)
16. Write out Revelation 1:3 in your own words.

STUDY IT

17. How does Proverbs 2:4 indicate you should study the Word?
18. What should be your goal in studying the Bible? (2 Timothy 2:15)

MEMORISE IT

19. What does God want you to do about His Word? (Deuteronomy 11:18a, Proverbs 7:3b)
20. In Matthew 4:4, 7, 10
 - a. How did Jesus overcome Satan's temptations three times?
 - b. Do you see any way you might apply this example to your own situation?
21. In Colossians 3:16 what do you think "Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly" means?
22. Write out Psalm 40:8 in your own words

MEDITATE ON IT

23. What promises are made to you if you continually meditate on God's Word? (Psalm 1:2 – 3, Joshua 1:8)

24. Luke 6:45. Do you think meditating on God's Word can affect your speech and actions? If so, how?
25. Besides being diligent in learning God's Word, what else should you do in order to understand it? (Psalm 119:18, 73, 125)
26. What does the Lord want you to do about such things as those in Philippians 4:8?
